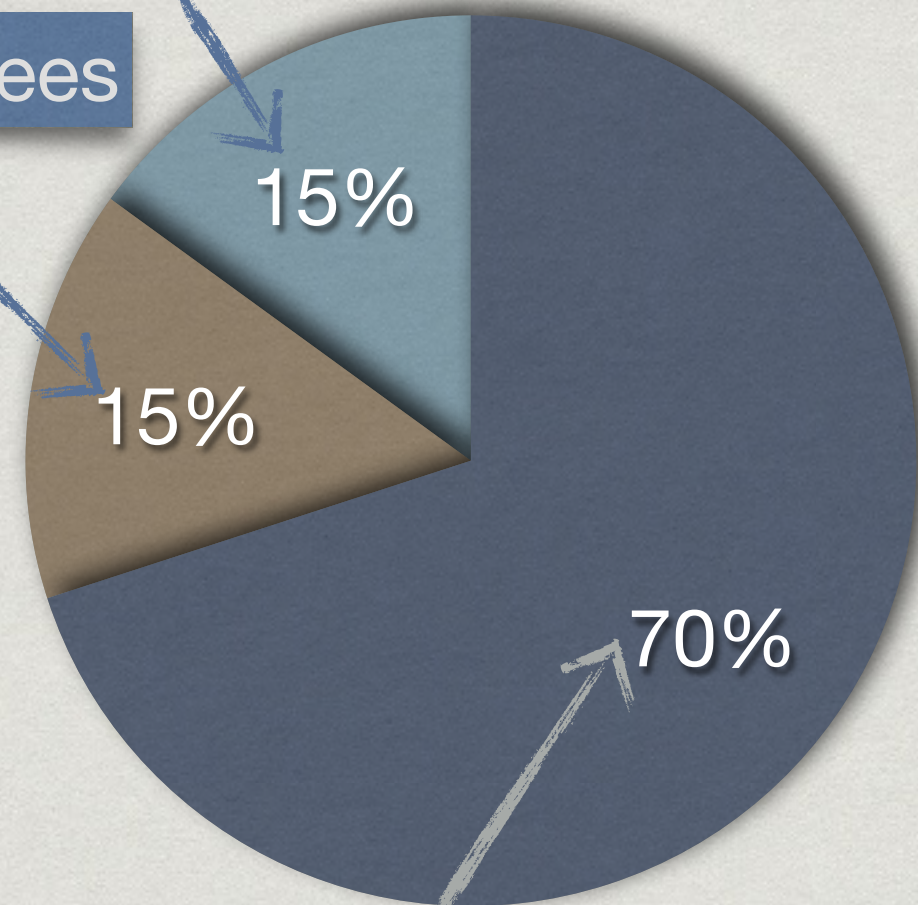

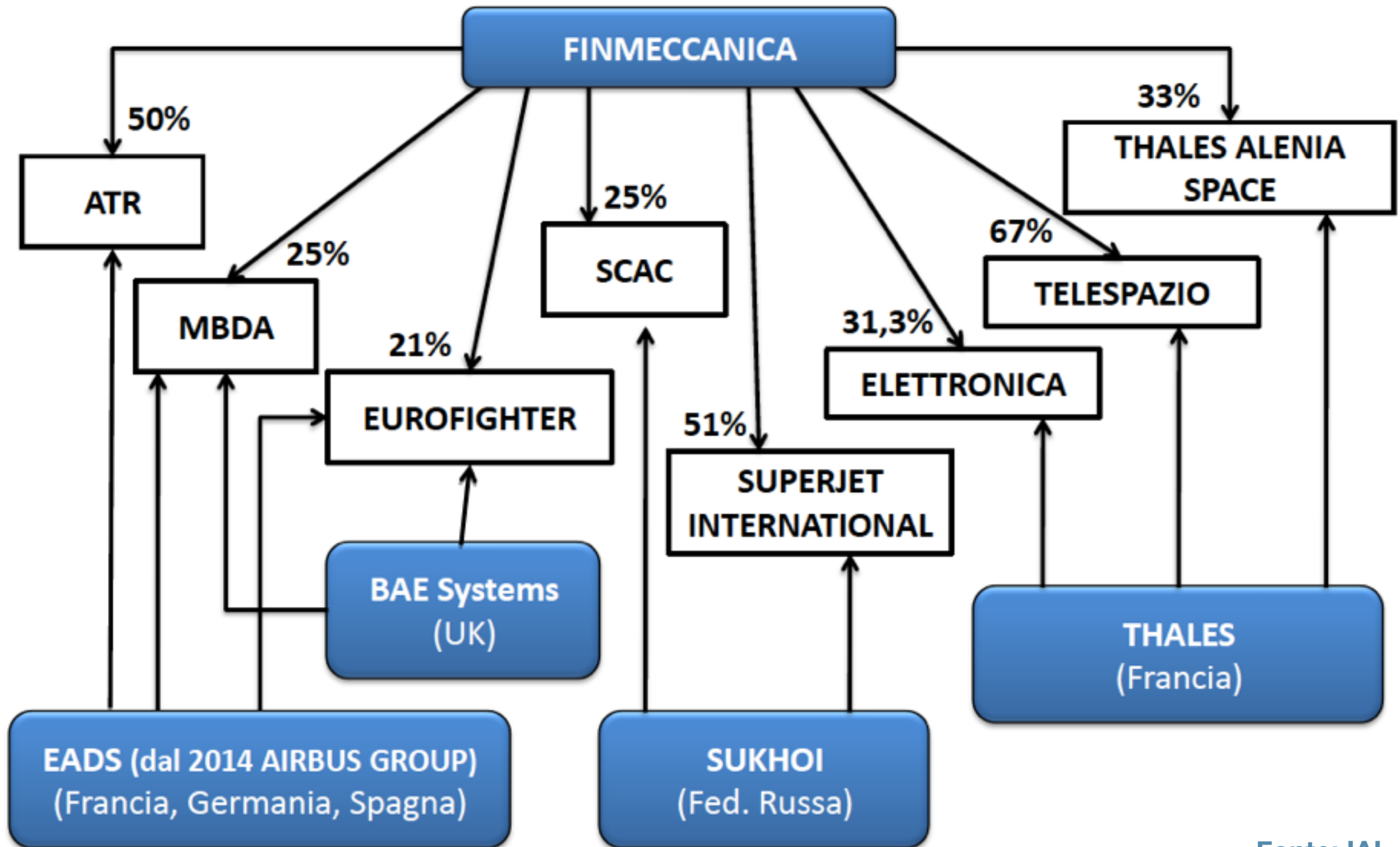

# Global Networks

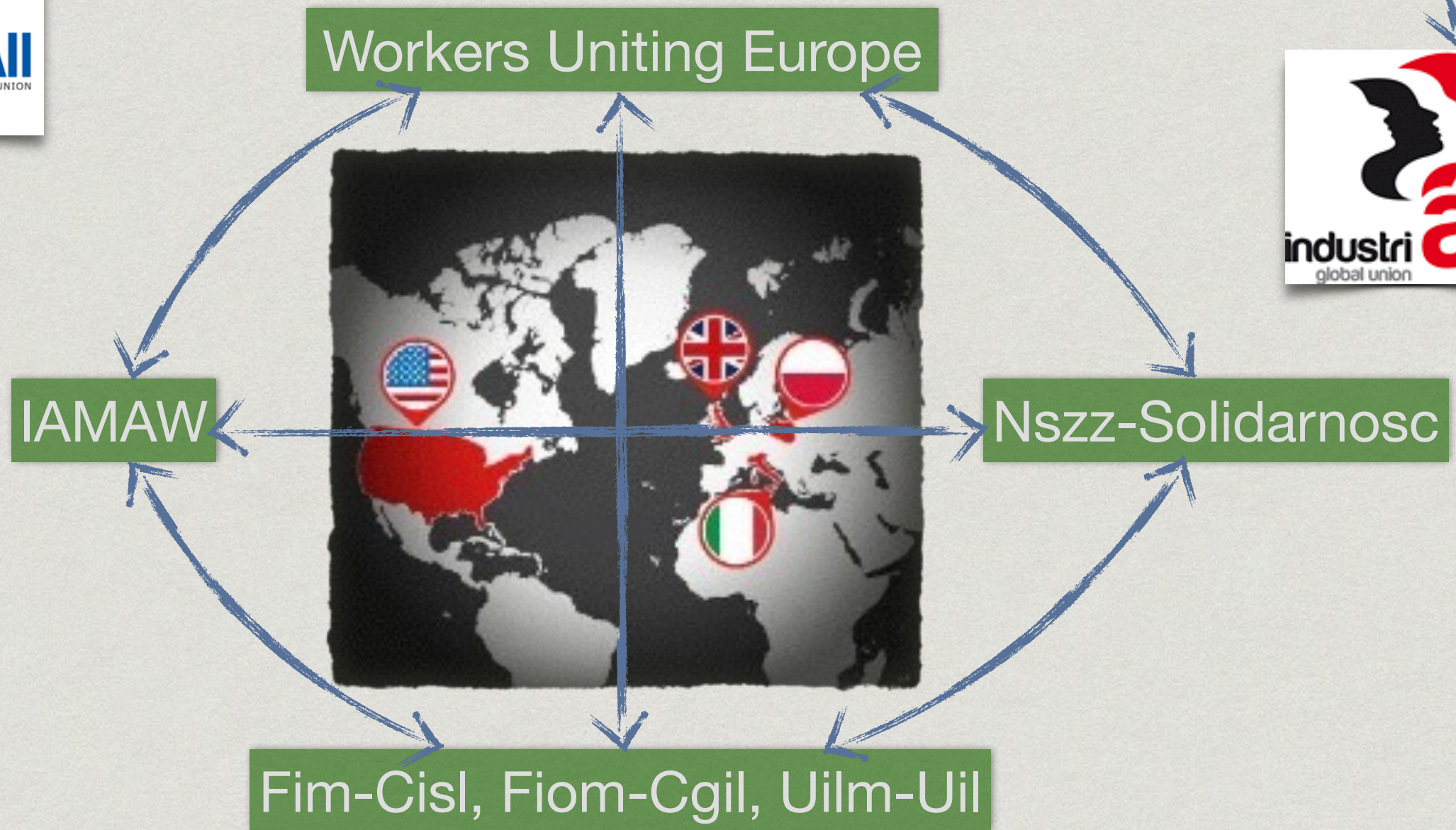


1. Linking all Unions present in same transnational company
